



2025 Block of the Month – Block 2 – King’s Crown

Please read entire instructions before cutting.


Cutting Instructions:

Color J: Cut (1) – 9 1/2” square

Color H: Cut (4) – 5” squares

Color E: Cut (1) 10 1/4” square

Color F: Cut (4) 5 3/8” squares



Sewing Directions:

1. We will use the 4 at one time method to make the E/F flying geese. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the (4) 5 3/8” squares.
2. Place (2) of the squares (color F) on each opposite corner of the 10 1/4” square, right sides together (Fig. 1).
3. Stitch 1/4” on each side of the diagonal line (see dotted lines).
4. Cut apart along the drawn line (solid line) and press towards triangles (Fig. 2).
5. You will have two units that look like Fig. 2.
6. Place another square (color F) on each corner of the large square as shown in Fig. 3.
7. Stitch 1/4” from each side of the diagonal line (on dotted lines in Fig. 3); cut down solid line. These four flying geese units should measure 9 1/2” by 5”. Trim as needed.
8. Lay out all the pieces as shown in the block image at the top of the page.
9. Join pieces together by row, sewing left to right.
10. Join rows to each other matching the vertical seams, starting at the top and working down.
11. You have completed the second block! Finished block size is around 18.5 inches.









Assembly Tips:

Trim “dog ears” on triangles after sewing and pressing the seam; be sure to press seams before putting sections together. Also, lay out pieces on the table to match illustration to avoid mixing pieces.
